NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, on behalf of our community members, do hereby state that the Village of Chatham reaffirms our commitment to a status of inclusion for all races, religions, nationalities, gender identities, sexual orientations, economic statuses and political affiliations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on behalf of all residents of the Village of Chatham we maintain our position that violence of any kind is unacceptable and condemn any act of aggression, hostility or violence against any member of our community based upon race, religion, nationality, gender identity, sexual orientation, economic status or political affiliation.
