NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by this august body that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham hereby does approve and endorse the application of the Crandell Theatre, Inc. for a grant under Title 9 of the Environmental Protection Act of 1993 for a project known as "The Crandell Theatre Restoration and Rehabilitation Project" located within this community.
